Acorn Pregnancy Counselling Centre was started in March 1995 by two friends who wanted to offer support to women and girls who unexpectedly found themselves pregnant. They worked from was a small room within a church building in Worthing. Clients could drop in to talk about their situation in confidence. The service expanded, took on more volunteers and a manager and moved to premises in Warwick Street. Counselling was also offered to those who had experienced abortion or miscarriage. The service moved to Buckingham Road and then to St Dunstan's Road.

In addition to the counselling being offered, the volunteers were invited into a local secondary school to talk to pupils about pregnancy issues. These sessions were soon taken up by other schools and a team was formed to take lessons in almost all local schools from Littlehampton to Shoreham.

Thousands of people have been impacted by this little charity in the last 30 years and we will be celebrating this on 29th March. If you would like to join us, please contact the office for details.
